Report dated 05.11.2015 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Manjit Singh as well as of complainant Raghbir Singh and Sarabjit Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the it is pure accident case and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.217 dated 29.11.2011 under Sections 337,338,279,427 IPC, Police Station, Patti, District Tarn Taran and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
