The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR
No.326, dated 30.11.2014, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act,
at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has
been in custody since 5.7.2016.

On the last date, the following order was passed :-

“ Learned Deputy Advocate General states that
all witnesses will be examined on or before

09.12.2016 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

Adjourned to 25.10.2016. In the meantime, the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to file affidavit with regard to aforesaid undertaking.”

Today, affidavit of Manmohan Kumar, SSP, Tarn Taran has been filed, as per which it has been undertaken that the prosecution will conclude its entire evidence on or before 9.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed but the trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence on or before 9.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
