This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.45 dated 06.07.2013 registered under Sections 452, 326, 324, 325, 148, 506 and 427 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel contends that petitioner could not cause representation on 13.09.2016 before the trial Court due to the demise of his paternal uncle. He further states that the Court had been benevolent and compassionate to allow such a liberty to the petitioner earlier as well. The absence before the trial Court was not intentional and wilful. The petitioner is not involved in any other FIR.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, in case the petitioner surrenders within three weeks from today, he be admitted to bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to payment of Rs.15,000/- as costs.

Disposed of.

Out of the costs amount of Rs.15,000/- a sum of Rs.10,000/- shall be paid to the complainant as compenstaion and remaining amount of Rs.5,000/- shall be deposited with Punjab State Legal Services Authority.
