JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present 3rd petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.55 dated 11.02.2008, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned Counsel for the parties heard.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner for his absence declared proclaimed offender on 11.10.2008 and arrested on 22.01.2009 and subsequently enlarged on bail. Once again, the petitioner absented himself on 12.05.2012 and declared proclaimed offender on 19.03.2013. Thereafter, he surrendered on 07.02.2015.

Learned State Counsel further submits that no doubt a direction was issued to expedite the disposal of the trial within six months, vide order dated 16.07.2015, however, on conclusion of the prosecution evidence, fresh application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. for additional evidence was moved by the prosecution. He assures that no time would be wasted by the prosecution.

It further transpires that another similar appeal for bail was got dismissed as withdrawn on 05.12.2015.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, no case for entertaining the petition for bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
