The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of Rajinder Kumar alias Sandhu and Manjit Singh both residents of Mallanwala, Tehsil and District Ferozepur as they are threatening the petitioners that they will be done to death if the petitioners would complain about them to any authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved a representation dated 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the matter and take appropriate action on their representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to look into the matter and

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in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
