Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Vijay Kumar @ Bittu in case FIR No.1380 dated 03.12.2015 under Sections 114, 116, 323, 186, 353, 332, 283, 147, 149, 506, 307 and 395 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat (**Annexure P-1**).

As per allegations in the FIR lodged by ASI Hawa Singh, an altercation took place due to wrong parking of the Car by three persons, namely, Subhash, Kirori Mal and Bittu. In the ensuing scuffle, they had also broken the camera of a Press Reporter-Rajesh.

It was contended that the accused persons were calling themselves Subhash, Bittu and Kirori Mal and Press Reporter Rajesh by way of his affidavit (**Annexure P-2**) has clearly deposed that said persons were not involved in the said occurrence. It was further contended that the petitioner is sought to be arrested only because of his alias as Bittu due to the reasons that a policeman has been beaten.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by SI Shri Krishan, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 01.02.2016, is made absolute.
