Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petitioner seeks quashing of the complaint bearing No.188/1/2011 dated 27.10.2008 (Jagdish Mittar v/s Shiv Kumar Mistri and others) (Annexure P-1) along with the summoning order dated 7.5.2012 (Annexure P-2) passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar.

Since the summoning order is revisable, the petitioner is relegated to avail the remedy before the Sessions Court. If the revision is filed within 30 days from today, the Sessions Court shall decide the same on merits notwithstanding the bar of limitation.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
