The petitioners seek anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in FIR No.86 dated 25.06.2013, registered under Sections 307, 353, 427 and 186 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Shimlapuri, Distt. Ludhiana.

Contentends that the petitioners were admitted to regular bail and they had been regularly appearing before the Court. However, instead of 29.08.2016, the date was wrongly noted down as 30.08.2016, which resulted in their absence on 29.08.2016. The petitioners are not involved in any other FIR. It is a case of no injury. The absence is neither wilful nor intentional.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper-book has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances, in case, the petitioners surrender before the trial Court within three days from today, they be admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to its satisfaction, if not involved and required in any other FIR.
