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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.03 dated 08.01.2014, registered under Sections 494, 495, 420 IPC, Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa and the consequent proceedings taken therein on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties. The FIR was got registered by respondent No.2 Nachhattar Singh against the petitioner.

Report has been received from the trial court after recording statements of the parties on compromise. The Court below has reported that compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion. Trial Court has also sent statements of complainant, petitioner and Ravinder Pal Kaur.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending against the petitioner. In view of the statements and report of the trial Court and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR(Crl.) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble the Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2012(10) SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted therein are

quashed qua petitioner.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
