The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.75 dated 16.05.2012, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Khanna, under Sections 15 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned State counsel states that in the last para of the order dated 27.10.2016, passed by this Court, it was inadvertently mentioned as Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala instead of Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna and prays for correcting the same.

of Police, Khanna, District Ludhiana, has been filed. Same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

As per said affidavit, the petitioner has been in custody for about 01 year and 11 months. It is also stated in the affidavit that the entire prosecution evidence will be concluded on or before 29.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that when the petitioner was on bail, he was involved in another case, as stated by learned State counsel on 29.09.2016, the instant petition stands dismissed. However, the learned trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail on 29.12.2016, in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence, subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
