Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.74 dated 15.08.2016, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Davinder Singh Randhawa, Superintendent, District Prison, Mansa, has been filed. Same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody for the last more than one month; the recovery effected from him is 30 grams intoxicant powder which falls in non-commercial quantity and no other case is pending against him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Deep Singh

and as per custody certificate, has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the facts that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than one month; recovery effected from him falls in non-commercial quantity and no other case is pending against him and without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
