Prayer in the petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for a direction to the respondent No.1 to take appropriate action against respondent No.2 for committing cheating and fraud upon the petitioner.

Virtually it is a direction seeking registration of the case and in view of the judgment rendered by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Sakiri Vasu vs. State of U.P. & ors.(2008) 2 SCC 409**, no such direction can be issued under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition, however, with liberty to avail the appropriate remedy as admissible under law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
