Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

By impugned order dated 30.07.2016 the bail granted to the petitioner has been cancelled because of his non-appearance before the Court.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner has not placed on record the order granting bail, by perusing the record this court finds that the petitioner was indeed on bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner makes statement that henceforth the petitioner would not make any default in appearing before the trial Court and would continue to appear with promptitude till the trial is completed and would cooperate in

completion of the trial, if the impugned order dated 30.07.2016 is set aside.

Accepting the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, I think the petitioner should be given one more chance to continue on bail as he was already granted bail by the trial Court.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) Rule is made absolute.
- (ii) Impugned order dated 30.07.2016 is set aside.
- (iii) The petitioner is granted anticipatory bail in FIR No.71 dated 30.06.2015 on the same bail bonds furnished by him before the trial Court.
- (iv) The petitioner would continue to appear before the trial Court with promptitude till the completion of trial.
- (v) Any further default would be viewed seriously by the trial Court.

Disposed of accordingly.
