The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeks a direction to the official respondents for registration of FIR against the private respondents besides seeking security claiming that the petitioner is a duly registered society and its members are devotees of religious personalities mentioned in the petition but respondent No.2 and his supporters with an intention to disrupt the peaceful activities had on 01.05.2016 interrupted the Satsang program in Namdev Bhawan, Kharar.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and going through the contents of the petition, the commission of any cognizable offence warranting action appears to be debatable.

Without entering into the said controversy, it is sufficient to observe here that a representation Annexure P-8 has already been submitted on behalf of the petitioner society to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar regarding the obstructions created in the Satsang program by respondent No.2 in the capacity as head of Vishav Manav Ruhani Kendra.

Even if, it is presumed that no cognizable offence is reflected from the grievance submitted by the petitioner, the circumstances mentioned in the representation Annexure P-8 are indicative of apprehension of breach of peace which can always be prevented depending upon the circumstances existing on the spot.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Ms. H.K. Athwal, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of, at this stage, with a direction that Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar will inquire into the matter at his own level, in the representation Annexure P-8 submitted on behalf of Sarvhitkari Adhyatmik Kendra. In case of any such representation having not been received in the said office, it will always be open to the petitioner to submit a fresh petition expecting that the grievance of the petitioner will be fairly looked into, in the interest of maintenance of peace and tranquility in the society, within a period of three to six months.
