Petitioner seeks concession of bail in a case registered at the instance of Balbir singh alleging that the petitioner along with his co-accused Kulwinder Singh and others had taken complainant to Tehsil complex on the pretext that he was to be got treated from the qualified doctors. He was intimidated and asked to sign certain documents besides getting his photograph clicked under the threat by the petitioner and other co-accused. A sale deed was got registered and six acres of his land was got transferred without paying any sale consideration.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he has allegedly witnessed the transfer deed in favour of Kulwinder Singh, co-accused of the petitioner. The petitioner happens to be nephew of complainant Balbir Singh and real brother of co-accused Kulwinder Singh in whose favour the property of the complainant has been got transferred without consideration stating that he was just like a son of the complainant. The complainant has been deprived of his property in favour of Kulwinder Singh by a transfer deed dated 4.3.2014 without payment of any money to him. The brother of the petitioner Kulwinder Singh, the beneficiary is an NRI. The connivance of the petitioner with Kulwinder Singh is writ large. A senior citizen has been deprived of his property by his real nephews.

No ground is made out for grant of bail to the petitioner at this stage. The petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court in case at any stage Kulwinder Singh is ready to give up his title in the property in favour of the complainant which he got pursuant to the above said transfer deed.
