JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner-Gurwinder Singh has sought direction to respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner & family members at the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7 and their supporters.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated July 27, 2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved to Director General of Police, Punjab Police, Chandigarh, but till date no substantive action has been taken on the said representation by the concerned authorities. Learned counsel further contends that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Amritsar Rural (Punjab) to decide his representation dated July 27, 2016 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. B.S. Cheema, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Amritsar Rural (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated July 27, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, there is threat perception, respondent No.2 shall provide necessary protection to the petitioner and his family members. However, it is further directed that inquiry be got conducted into the allegations unfolded in the representation (Annexure P-4) from an officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police, under his supervision.
