JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioners, namely, Tarsem Kumar @ Sanjay Danter and Iqbal Hussain in case FIR No.0382 dated 13.12.2015, under Sections 61/1/14 of the Excise Act, registered with Police Station Tripuri Town, Patiala, District Patiala.

Allegations are that both the petitioners were unauthorisedly involved in the sale of country made liquor meant for sale in Haryana only and on being confronted both of them fled away leaving behind 55 bottles of such liquor.

It was contended that the petitioners have been falsely implicated because of the previous complaint made by them against police officials conniving with local Wine Traders for having beaten them up. That apart, no recovery is to be effected.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Jasbir Singh, concedes the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 01.02.2016, is made absolute.
