This is 2nd petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.473 dated 25.9.2015, under Sections 418, 420, 120-B and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Faridabad Kotwali, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that there is no allegation against the petitioner and in fact the petitioner has not duped any person. He states that the complainant has filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act against M/s Uday Industries, in which the petitioner is not a partner and the complaint filed under Section 138 of N.I. Act is totally against the contents of the FIR.

On the other hand, learned State counsel states that the petitioner along with his son Anmol Bhatt has duped number of persons by

receiving iron raw material and not settling the dues. As many as seven other complainants have got their statements recorded in support of the complaint.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The earlier petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. i.e. Criminal Misc. No. M-37429 of 2015 titled 'Jagdish Lal vs. State of Haryana' was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 19.1.2016. The allegations against the petitioner are serious and apart from the allegations made in the FIR, statements of as many as seven other complainants have been recorded, which indicts the petitioner. In this manner, the petitioner has duped number of persons by receiving iron raw material and not settling the dues.

Hence, no ground for grant of relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

The present petition is hereby dismissed.
