The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 04.11.2014, in a case registered at the instance of Inspector Lakhwinder Singh on the basis of a secret information that the petitioner, along with 5-6 other persons, was present in a brick kiln, planning to commit *dacoities*. One pistol, two live cartridges and 400 grams of intoxicant powder was recovered from the petitioner.

The application for bail of the petitioner has been opposed, *inter alia*, on the ground that the petitioner is also involved in other cases.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner has been in custody for the last about two years. Recoveries have already been effected. The allegations of mala-fide also appear to be probable.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to a condition that the petitioner will not indulge in similar activities during pendency of the trial.
