By virtue of this petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C, the petitioner has sought bail during the pendency of trial in case FIR No.432 dated 13.06.2016 under Section 379-B IPC registered at Police Station Camp, District Palwal.

The case as projected by the prosecution is that on 13.06.2016 at about 4.00 AM, the complainant Satya Bhan, after performing his duty at Tata Motors, was returning to his village Phoolwari on bicycle. When he reached at Asawata turn, two persons came on motorcycle and stopped their motorcycle in front of his bicycle. One of them took out a knife from his pocket and asked him to hand over the cash and mobile phone. Subsequent thereto, they took away a sum of ₹2400/- and Nokia mobile phone from his pocket forcibly.

Undisputedly, the petitioner was arrested in this case on 14.06.2016. When he was subjected to custodial interrogation, Nokia mobile phone belonging to the complainant is alleged to have been recovered from him. After completion of investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been presented, disposal of which is likely to take sufficient long time.

In the given circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for indefinite period.

Moreover, co-accused of the petitioner, namely Ravinder, has already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide order dated 22.07.2016 passed in CRM No. M-24003 of 2016.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspect of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner Avtar is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, during the pendency of the trial.
