This common order shall dispose of two aforementioned petitions seeking anticipatory bail on behalf of two petitioners/accused, namely, Sumit Gupta and Birendra Kumar in case bearing FIR No.492 dated 17.06.2015, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

As per the allegations levelled by the complainant-Dr. Rajveer Singh, both the petitioners/accused along with other non-applicant/co-accused had induced and received a sum of Rs.43 Lacs approximately for

securing the admission of son of the complainant in D.Y.Patil Medical College, Mumbai under the 'Management Quota' seats. Neither the admission has been got secured nor the money has been returned.

Learned Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made.

Accordingly, both the present petitions are dismissed.
