The husband of the petitioner along with one Daljit Singh had allegedly obtained a sum of Rs. 7,50,000/- on the pretext of sending complainant Amarjot Singh Walia abroad. Later on, a compromise was effected for returning only a sum of Rs. 3 lacs out of which Rs. 1 lac was paid. Remaining amount was not paid to the complainant, so, an FIR has been registered against the petitioner, her husband and Daljit Singh.

A bank draft of Rs. 1.5 lacs has been handed over to the investigating officer in the name of the complainant under the interim order passed by this Court.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the civil liability of the petitioner and the right of the complainant to recover any balance amount due, this petition can be allowed.

This petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, she will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that she will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner. The bank draft handed over by the petitioner under the interim order passed by this Court to the investigating officer would be given by the investigating officer to the complainant against receipt without prejudice to the other rights of the parties.
