The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.152, dated 30.6.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1984 , at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press this petition and the petitioner who is presently residing abroad would come back to India on or before 30.11.2016 and
