INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 01.03.2016, registered at Police Station Shahbad, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record. Police record has also been produced.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of Saroj Bala. As per the allegations,

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the petitioner along with co-accused took the complainant in a car by misleading her; snatched her ear-rings etc. on the way and left her near village Surajgarh by stopping the car.

Learned State counsel has brought into my notice that 30 FIRs have already been registered against the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts that the petitioner is an habitual offender and is committing such type of offences time and again, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
