The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83 dated 25.07.2016, registered at Police Station City Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 308, 323, 148 and 149 IPC.

On 26.09.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner caused simple injury and the co-accused to whom serious injury(s) has been attributed is in custody.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S.Thind, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is directed to appear before the concerned Investigating Officer on 10.10.2016 within 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or any other day as required by the investigating officer and in case of his doing so, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
