JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought bail, during the pendency of the trial, in case bearing FIR No.46 dated 26.02.2016, under Sections 436, 147, 148, 149, 427, 186, 353, 188 IPC read with Section 3 and 4 of The Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, registered at Police Station Julana.

This case has emerged out of the Jaat agitation occurred in the State of Haryana in the month of February, 2016. No doubt, FIR was registered against some unknown persons but subsequently, petitioner has been nominated as one of the accused. He was arrested in this case on 3rd March, 2016 and after subjecting him to custodial interrogation, he was remanded to judicial custody, meaning thereby, he was not required for further custodial interrogation. After completion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C., has already been presented. The conclusion of the trial is not likely in the near future and would certainly take sufficient long time. Moreover, in another case registered against the petitioner, he has

already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide order dated 3rd October, 2016 passed in *CRM-M-34633 of 2016*. The instant case is not on different footing than that of the case in which he has already been granted the concession of bail.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
