Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 and 4 to conclude the investigation and to submit the report under Section 173 Cr.PC in case FIR No.73 dated 24.10.2015 under Sections 283/427 IPC registered at Police Station Kotfatta, District Bathinda at the instance of BDPO, Bathinda against private respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the FIR was registered on 24.10.2015, but till date, the investigation has not been completed by the police. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda is directed to look into the contents of representation dated 5.9.2016 (Annexure P-3) made by the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
