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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.19 dated 02.03.2015, registered under Sections 363/366A IPC & Section 8 of POSCO Act (Sections 302, 376, 511,120-B IPC added later on), Police Station City I Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only role given to the petitioner was that he had picked up both the girls from the class room and had dropped them on the bus-stand and the main accused Pritam Singh and Surinder Pal Singh are in custody. He further states that Section 120-B has been added and pursuant to the order dated 06.10.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 06.10.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
