Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a case i.e. FIR No.165, dated 04.11.2014 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali was registered against respondent No.4 but no action has been taken against him because he is an influential person.

The petitioner had earlier approached this Court by way of petition i.e. CRM-M-5863-2016 which was disposed of vide order dated 19.02.2016 with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of petitioner (Annexure P7) within the framework of law.

Accordingly, respondent No.2 has passed an order dated 09.08.2016 (Annexure P-10) wherein it has been stated that respondent No.4-accused in order to evade his arrest is hiding somewhere and,

therefore, proclamation proceedings have been initiated against him and Superintendent of Police (Investigation) has been asked to take immediate action for arrest of respondent No.4.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Once proclamation proceedings against respondent No.4 have been initiated, the prayer of petitioner no more survives. In the representation dated 05.08.2016 (Annexure P-9), petitioner has prayed that action be taken against respondent No.4, which the Senior Superintendent of Police has already taken note of and has directed the Superintendent of Police (Investigation) to take necessary action.

In view of above, this Court finds no merit in the present petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.
