Petitioner seeks the direction to official respondent Nos.2 to 5 for protection of life and liberty and also for registration of FIR against respondent No.6.

A perusal of the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 5 shows that an agreement to sell was executed and earnest money was paid which has not been returned. Police has come to the conclusion that this is a civil dispute and petitioner should file a civil suit.

It being so, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate, if he feels that some criminal offence is committed. However, it shall always be open to the petitioner to file a civil suit for enforcement of the agreement to sell.
