Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 05.07.2016.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with 40-45 other co-accused armed with Kirpan, Datar and Dangs came to the house of complainant and attacked him, as a result of the same, he was followed by the complainant party. It is not a case of grievous injury. Petitioner armed with Dang is alleged to have assaulted Mohinder and Sandeep. As per the medical evidence available, Mohinder and Sandeep have not received any grievous injury at the hands of the petitioner. Petitioner, in above said circumstances, can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
