The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail on medical grounds in FIR No.109 dated 07.06.2015 registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Reply filed by the learned State counsel is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the last five months the petitioner is under treatment and has not been properly looked into and there is need for amputation of his leg.

Per contra, learned State counsel submits that looking to the ailment of the petitioner namely diabetes, the petitioner himself has to manage the diabetes. That apart, the reference was made to the fact that the CMO, Civil Hospital Kapurthala has referred the petitioner to higher hospital and accordingly he was taken to Government Medical College, Amritsar, which is higher hospital. Learned State counsel then submits

that the trial has been started and three witnesses have already been examined and the prosecution undertakes to examine all the remaining witnesses within a week from 1st December, 2016 and shall not ask for adjournment for production of official witnesses before the trial Court. The statement is accepted.

In that view of the matter, the trial Court is directed to examine all the witnesses from 1st December, 2016 and fix the case on day-to-day basis for disposal and in any case complete the trial on or before 17th December, 2016.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with above directions.
