The present petition has been filed praying for the directions for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, who have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their parents.

Pursuant to the notice having been issued to the respondents for today, learned counsel for the State has filed reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 along with the Statement of petitioner No.1-Sarita (Annexure R-1) as well as petitioner No.2-Lovekush (Annexure R-2). A perusal of the statements made by both the petitioners show that that they do not have any threat to their life and liberty from the other side. Said reply along with the statements of both the petitioners produced in Court today, are taken on record.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the validity of marriage and taking into consideration the statements made by both the

petitioners, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly dismissed.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the SSP concerned, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
