Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.12 dated 05.02.2016, registered at Police Station Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 307, 224, 225, 148, 149, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody since 19.02.2016 and the similarly situated co-accused (to whom also the grievous injury under Section 307 IPC was not attributed) was granted bail by this Court vide order dated 16.09.2016, passed in Criminal Misc.No.M-32323 of 2016.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Gurdip Singh, has accepted that the main accused is Baby.

Therefore, I find no reason to take different view and deem it

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appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
