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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.244 & 245 dated 30.04.2016, registered under Sections 380, 411 & 457 IPC at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat.

It is not disputed that the petitioner was arrested and is in jail since 25.06.2016 in the aforesaid two FIRs.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner is facing en number of prosecution for commission of robbery and theft. The petitioner is resident of interior part of District Guna. That apart looking to the fact that the petitioner is facing number of prosecutions, without meaning any adverse observation against him, it is not possible to release the petitioner on bail and the only possible order is that the trial

Court should be directed to complete the trial within a stipulated period in the present FIRs. Trial is triable by Magistrate and looking to the fact that the petitioner is in jail since 25.06.2016 it would be appropriate that the trial Court take out the FIRs on day-to-day basis and decide the same in any case on or before 28.02.2017. The prosecution is directed to fully cooperate with the court in the conduct of trial of these FIRs by producing the witnesses.

It is made clear that the trial Court is free to take action against the police officials/officers and prosecution agency if they do not cooperate.

In view of the above, the petitions are disposed of with direction to the trial Court as aforesaid.
