Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.481 dated 14.09.2016 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 323, 341, 427, 506 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat.

This Court vide order dated 27.09.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioners (except petitioner No.7-Rashid) subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 27.09.2016, petitioners (except petitioner No.7) have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Raj Pal has stated that in terms of above order, petitioners (except petitioner No.7) have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 27.09.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners (except petitioner No.7) shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
