This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0071 dated 28.08.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 326 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Kanwan, Tehsil and District Pathankot.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Learned State counsel contends that injuries under Section 326 of the IPC have been attributed to the petitioner.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner. No case for

anticipatory bail is made out, at this stage.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
