Report dated 21.4.2016 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Sanjay Bansal, Ashraf, Satish as well as of complainant Kiran Devi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure property dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.437 dated 13.08.2015 under Sections 420, 448,

379 IPC Police Station, Sarai Khawaja, Faridabad and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
