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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.835 dated 16.09.2015 registered under Sections 147, 149, 342, 323 and 506 IPC at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 makes categorical statement that the compromise (Annexure P-2) has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the parties further submits that dispute has been resolved with the intervention of respectable persons and therefore, complainant as well as the accused should be allowed to compound the offence by way of compromise.

On 23.07.2016 this court had directed the parties to appear before the concerned JMIC for getting recorded their statements regarding the compromise. Now there is report form the District and Sessions Judge, Karnal that the statements have been recorded and the compromise has been found to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In that view of the matter and looking to the nature of offence, in my opinion, the compounding be allowed in the light of the decision by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543***. In that view of the matter I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-33583 OF 2015 is allowed by way of compounding/compromise.
- (ii) The FIR No.835 dated 16.09.2015 registered under Sections 147, 149, 342, 323 and 506 IPC at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
