In FIR No.293 dated 25.11.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 212, 216, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 8 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 registered at Police Station Sadar, Samana, District Patiala, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Vide order dated 28.09.2016, this Court had granted *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
