The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 118 dated 21.06.2016 registered at Police Station Tigaon, Faridabad under Section 306 IPC.

The petitioner is in custody since 15.07.2016. The deceased was married 11 years ago and they have two children. The complaint was lodged by father with the allegation that all the relatives used to harass and beat his daughter. It was also reported that three months prior to the incident the harassment had increased. There are two children who are in the age group of 7 and 9 years.

Learned State counsel submits that last complaint was made in 2011 but a compromise was effected.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate with a rider that he would not tamper with evidence.
