Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.68 dated 05.07.2016, under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and cross-case bearing DDR No.45 dated 13.06.2016, under Sections 323, 34 IPC, and DDR No.35 dated 05.07.2016 vide which offences under Sections 324, 326 IPC added, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, petitioners seek quashing of the said FIR as well as

DDRs on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners in respective petitions jointly submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court vide order dated 27.09.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned SDJM, Gidderbaha stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and valid.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.68 dated 05.07.2016, under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149 IPC and cross-case bearing DDR No.45 dated 13.06.2016, under Sections 323, 34 IPC, and DDR No.35 dated 05.07.2016 vide which offences under Sections 324, 326 IPC added, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed qua petitioners only in both these petitions, by way of compounding/compromise.
