M.M.S. BEDI, JUDGE (ORAL)

The petitioner has prayed for interim temporary bail for a period of three months only, to get himself treated for his ailment, he being HIV positive (AIDS). He had been granted interim bail for the said period and is required to surrender on 17.05.2016 i.e. today at 2:00 PM as per the orders passed by this Court.

On asking of the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner informs that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the case is fixed for defence evidence. The present petition for relief for a period of three months has already outlived its utility, petitioner having availed the relief. Oral request has been made for extension of interim bail, on the basis of the present situation of the petitioner stating that he is still admitted in the hospital.

In view of above circumstances, this petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous without any prejudice to the right of the petitioner to avail any remedy after surrendering before the trial Court. It will be open to the jail authorities or the trial Court to grant any relief, on medical ground, if deemed appropriate.
