On having been intercepted on March 13, 2016 along with Binder, the petitioner escaped.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR but he is alleged to have fired gun shot at the police party while the pallets hit the Car.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. March 21, 2016 and the chances of tampering with the evidence are remote, the prosecution witnesses being police officials, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
