Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakha Singh in case FIR No.100 dated 19.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 324, 506, 148, 149 Indian Penal Code and Section 326 IPC added later on registered with Police Station Chatiwind, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

The accused and the complainant party are admittedly related to each other and their appears to be dispute over a piece of land taken on lease by the complainant party.

It is contended that even as per the allegations in the FIR the

role attributed to the petitioner is of inflicting injury by *Dattar* on the middle finger of the right hand of the complainant Milkha Singh.

It is further contended that the said injury has been opined to be simple in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 5th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
