The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.91 dated 16.07.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Nurpur Bedi, Distt. Ropar.

Learned counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has the capacity to discharge the entire liability and repay the amount of Rs.18.00 lacs (approx.) to the complainant(s), in case, he is admitted to interim bail for a period of 12 weeks. He further states that co-accused Kuldeep Singh has already been admitted to bail by this Court.

Heard.

The petitioner is the main accused. This Court feels that the case of the complainant(s) would be advanced better in case, the submission made by the petitioner is accepted.

Accordingly, the petitioner be admitted to interim bail for a

period of three weeks from the date of release, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on the date and time to be noticed by the releasing Court.

The first instalment of Rs.5.00 lacs be paid on or before 07.12.2016. In case, the first instalment is not paid within the stipulated period, the State shall be at liberty to file appropriate petition for cancellation of his bail. It is also made clear that in case, the undertaking made at bar is not complied with, the instant petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed, without further notice.

Anything noticed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
