The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.180 dated 16.11.2014, under Sections 420/465/468/471 IPC and Section 12-B of the Passport Act, 1967, registered at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Allegations against the present petitioner, namely, Harpreet Singh s/o Kulwant Singh are that he got issued a passport under the name of Gurpreet Pannu on the false and forged documents and on the strength of such passport travelled abroad.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the present petition and further undertakes that the petitioner would duly surrender within a period of one week from today and prays for indulgence of this Court that if thereafter an application for regular bail is filed, the same be directed to be decided forthwith.

It is further observed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Investigating Officer/Illaq Magistrate within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking regular bail, such application would be decided strictly on merits and the Court would make every endeavor to expedite the disposal of the same.
