In FIR No.03 dated 05.01.2016, registered under Sections 61/1/a of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

This Court had made an order dated September 28, 2016 granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner and directing the State counsel to find out whether any similar type of offence or any other offence is registered against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State upon instructions from Head Constable Raj Pal, makes a statement that no offence is pending against the petitioner and custody of the petitioner is not required.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated September 28, 2016 granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
