Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.184 dated 07.05.1998 for offence under Sections 326, 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur and all consequential proceedings arising thereto.
