By virtue of the instant petition moved under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought quashing of the summoning order dated 06.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) in complaint ARBT Case No.4/2012 dated 01.05.2012, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 469, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

At the very outset of the arguments, it has emerged that petitioner has not availed the remedy by way of revision before the Sessions Court against the impugned order dated 06.06.2016 and has filed the instant petition straight way.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition. However, seeks liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law including the filing of revision before the Sessions Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
